



Ockanickon Scout Reservation Program Area COVID-19 Mitigation – Revised 02 JUN 2021

All program areas at OSR will practice the following Non-Pharmaceutical Interventions (NPIs) to mitigate the possible spread of COVID-19 at camp.

1. All participants will be encouraged to practice hand hygiene between program sessions.
2. Scouts are encouraged to find other scouts in the “family unit/cohort”* to take badges together.
3. Scouts will sit by “family unit/cohort” in all sessions. If a scout is attending a session without a member of their “family unit/cohort” they will sit individually.
4. All programs with partner work will put emphasis on working with scouts in your “family unit/cohort”. Scouts without members of their “family unit/cohort” will be partnered with other individuals but must following the Council’s published masking policy.
5. Program Areas will maintain seating charts for every session should the need for contact tracing arise.
6. It is recommended to bring a lawn/camp chair for use while in a session. We are not able to safely fit all participants around picnic tables.
7. All session areas and materials will be sanitized after each use.
8. Area Capacities have been reduced to reduce crowding.
9. Masking will be enforced as per the Council’s published masking policy.
10. Programs will take place outside whenever possible to allow for better air flow and spacing.

*A “family unit/cohort” is a troop of any size or a group of staff as determined by Camp Administration. It must remain stable without change in membership while at Camp. Scouts, adults, and staff cannot be part of more than one family unit/cohort at a time.
