Background Clearances & Adult Leader Registration

 - FBI fingerprint clearance (affidavit for 10+ years of residency)
- Out-of-state residents present signed affidavit

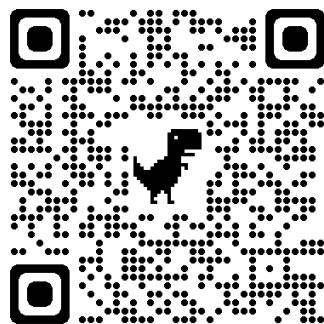
1. Troop Rosters – Should be submitted no later than two weeks form your arrival. Can be sent to: logistics@ockanickon.org
2. Unit Swim Record – If you are a unit that pre-tests before arriving at camp. Please submit you unit swim record no later than two weeks from your arrival. Can be sent to: logistics@ockanickon.org
3. Annual Health and Medical Record – Submitted no later than two weeks prior to your arrival if using the pre-check. Otherwise, must be complete upon arrival to camp.
4. Pre-Event Screening Form – Should be completed by all youth and adult participants prior to arriving in the parking lot at OSR.



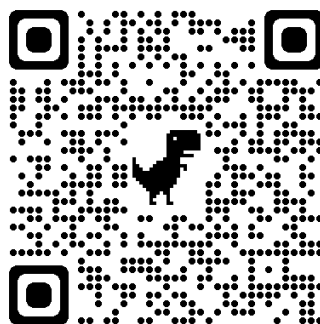

Adult Roster



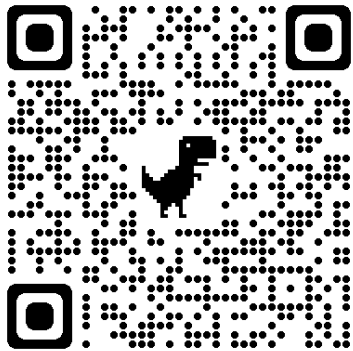
All units must submit a complete roster no later than 2 weeks prior to their arrival at camp. All scouts and adults attending camp must be listed on the unit roster.

- 8pm Flag Ceremony, followed by Opening Campfire





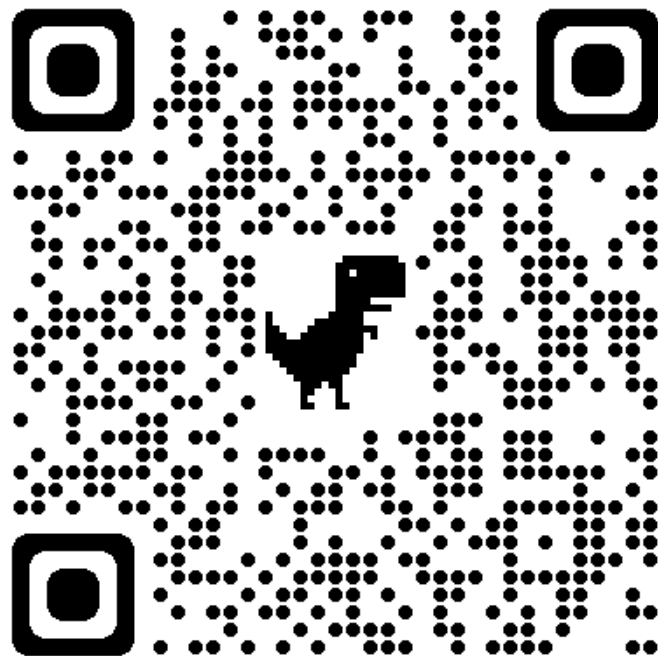

Reporting Food Allergies and Restrictions to Camp

** In most cases the OSR Food Service team is able to accommodate the needs of our scouts. In extreme cases, scouts can bring their own food from home. All of this must go through the Camp Health Officer and Food Service Director prior to arrival.**

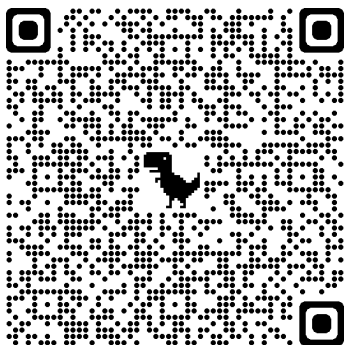




Annual Health and Medical Record

National Camp Accreditation Program (NCAP) Standard HS-503-1 Section A-1, Long Term Camps: Upon arrival, each camper, adult leader and staff member must present to the Camp Health Officer or designee an up-to-date BSA Annual Health and Medical Record form signed by a licensed medical professional . Parts A, B1, B2 and C are required for camps longer than 72 hours and for those scouts that are participating in high adventure activities.

For a form to be considered valid, all areas must be completed. The providers signature must be dated no latter than 12 calendar months during your stay at OSR.

Prescription Medications

Units have one of two options with daily medications:

Option 1: The unit holds all medications except for refrigerated medications and narcotics. The unit is responsible for distribution and storage. All medications kept in the site must be kept in a solid locking box, that has no other purpose that to store medications. (Cars, troop trailers and personal foot lockers are not acceptable forms of storage).

Option 2: All medications are stored in the health lodge and distributed by the health lodge staff.





Refrigerated Medications

All medications that require refrigeration must be stored in the health lodge. The health lodge staff will store them in a lock box inside the refrigerator.

Please plan accordingly for transport of these medications. i.e., cold packs and coolers.





Standing Orders

Our medical staff operate under the supervision of our Council Health Supervisor, Dr. Brett Harrison MD.

We are authorized through standing orders to perform basic first aid and limited OTC medication. Any cases outside of those orders will be sent for more advanced treatment.

Unit leaders are responsible for transporting their Scouts for treatment. OSR staff can assist in providing 2-deep leadership in the site if necessary.





AHMR Pre-Check

- Units have the option to have their medical forms pre-checked
- Forms must be mailed to the below address no later than 2 weeks prior to their arrival
 - Please send a complete roster with your forms
- The unit point of contact will be contacted with any form issues
- Please be prepared to bring any missing parts to camp with you

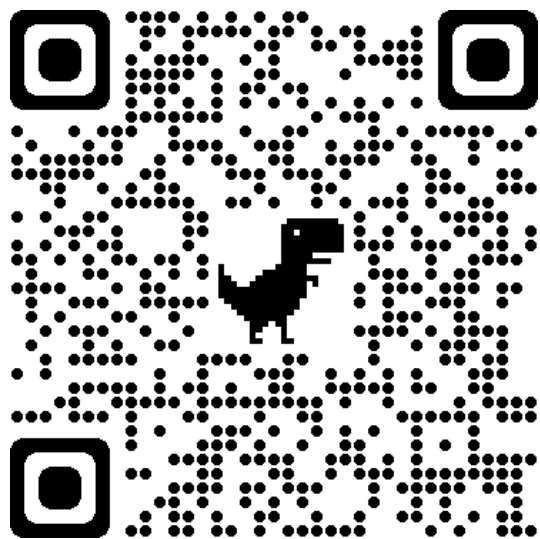
