



Ockanickon Scout Reservation COVID-19 Mitigation Plan 2022 – Revised 12 APR 2022

**RISK STATEMENT:** Ockanickon Scout Reservation strives to provide a safe and meaningful program. The decision to attend camp should be discussed and decided on by each individual household in the unit. Ockanickon will take every reasonable step to protect our participants and staff. If you decide to come to camp you are accepting that there is a possible risk of exposure to and contraction of COVID-19.

**MITIGATION PLAN:**

1. All participants and staff will be required to complete a temperature check upon arrival and answer pre-screening questions.
2. Those who have a temperature above 100.4 degrees or who answer yes to screening questions will be asked to leave property.
3. Camp participants are encouraged to remain with other members of their unit while taking badges and participating in other camp activities.
4. Regular cleaning will be performed in all public/high traffic areas in camp. Unit areas in the campsite are to be cleaned by the unit.
5. Units and Staff will take part in daily symptom screening.
6. Units and Staff will regularly participate in hand hygiene (soap and water or sanitizer).
7. Units and staff are encouraged, but not required to receive the COVID-19 vaccine at least 2 weeks prior to their stay at OSR.
8. Units are asked to communicate with Camp Administration if anyone in your unit tests positive or becomes symptomatic for COVID-19 within 10 days after your departure.
9. Camp Administration will notify units that were in attendance during a week in which a COVID outbreak is identified.
10. The medical staff will follow standing orders for any individual exhibiting possible COVID-19 symptoms.
